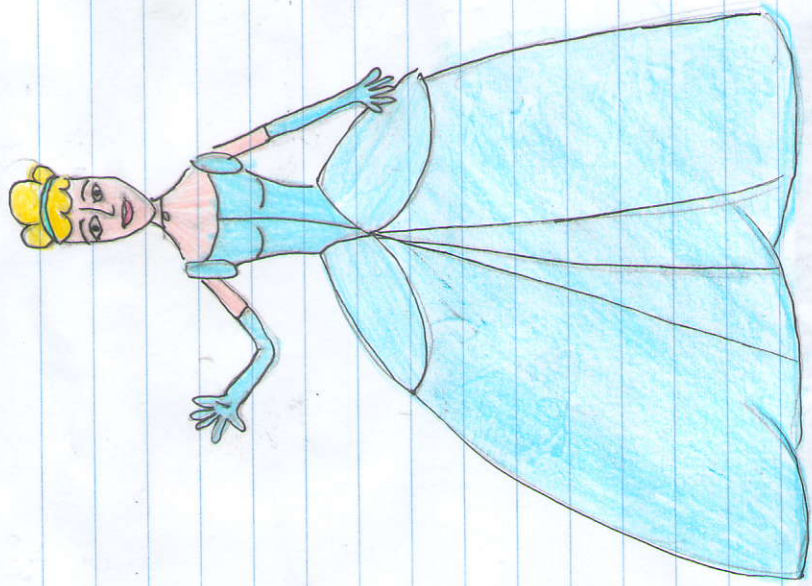
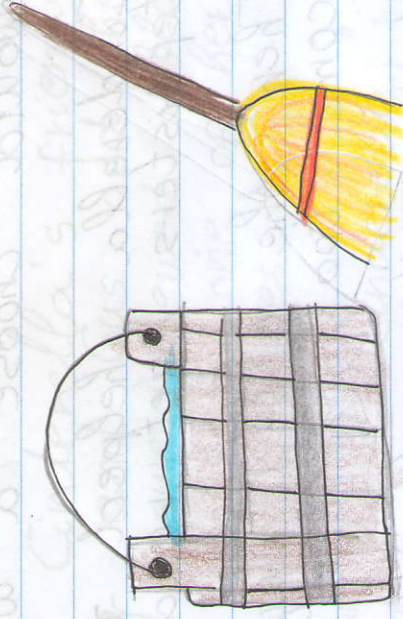


Cinderella

were invited to a ball.

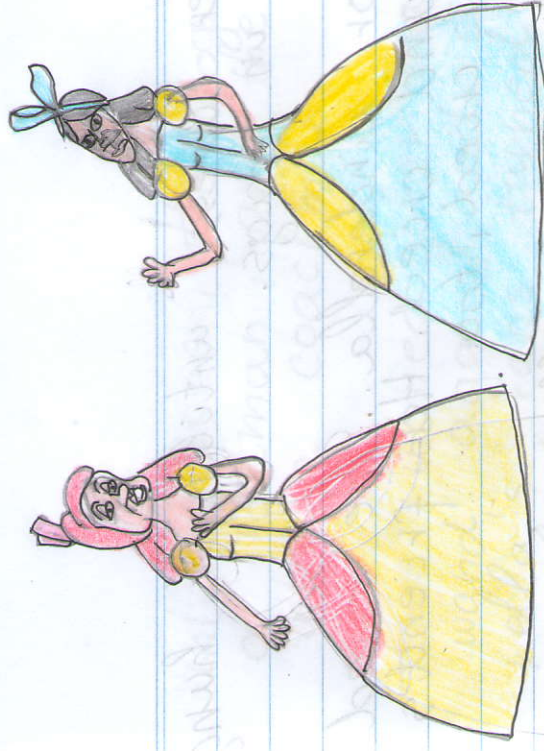
At the ball the prince

godmother.

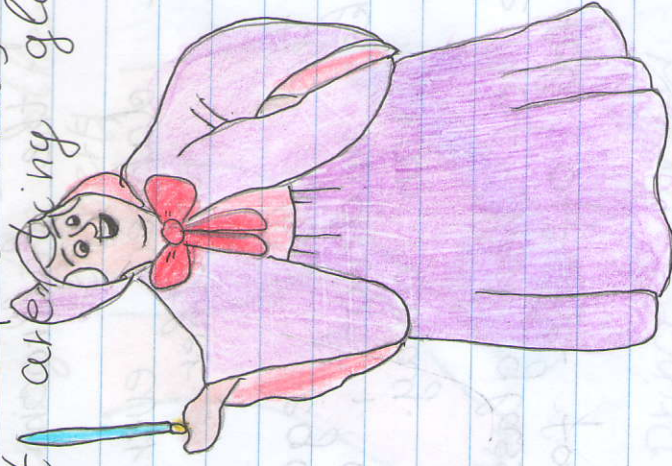
"Bring me a pumpkin,"

When the Prince saw cinderella, (and) he fell in love. Cinderella and the prince whirled around the ballroom.

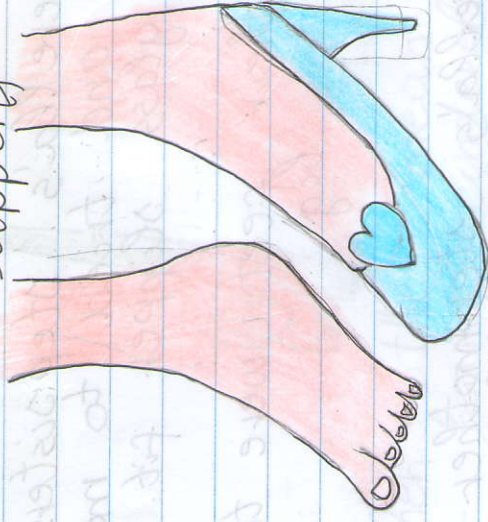
They danced every dance together.

the slipper.

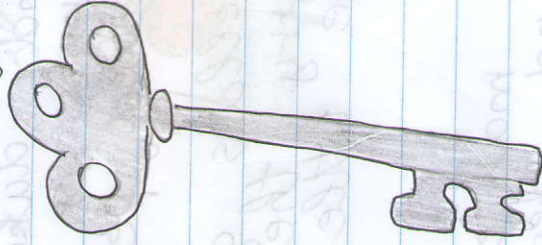
Cinderella's step sisters

"That's all right. I have the other one right here," said cinderella, pulling the slipper out of her pocket

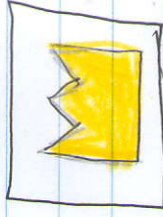
The grand duke put the slipper on cinderella's foot. It fitted perfectly.

"Cinderella's going to (marry) marry the prince!" sang the little birds.

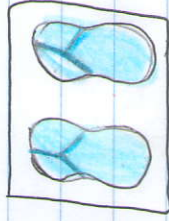
Cinderella married the prince and they lived happily ever after

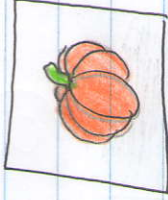
